Although Jilani had been leading the Dances for some years before meeting Muiz, she asked him to become her Dance Leadership Mentor in 2005, and in 2006, he initiated her onto the Sufi path.

Jilani is now a Dance Leadership Mentor with mentees of her own in the UK, Ireland, France, and Spain. She teaches around the UK, and several times a year in France, and last summer expanded her work to Spain. She has also led 2 week-long Dance and Sufi Practice retreats in Morocco.



Tamil Robert began drumming for Jilani's Dance circle some 7 or 8 years ago, and playing guitar for her a few years after that. He began leading the Dances himself 2 years ago, and he and Jilani have begun leading together, and he leads her weekly Dance and Sufi Practices circle at their

home when she's traveling.

In December of 2016 Muiz and Jilani will be in Morocco together, sharing leadership of a 12-day Dance and Sufi Practices retreat.
